

(Hold up your index finger, and use your other hand to point to each section of the index finger as you say "Father, Spirit and Son.")



3. Jesus came down to earth, he died, was buried, and rose again.

(Hold up your middle finger and form a peace sign with your index finger. As you say "Jesus came down to earth," trace the inside of your index finger downward and then the inside of your middle finger upward as you say "and rose again.")



4. The Church is the Bride of Christ.

(Hold up your ring finger with other two fingers and point to it as you say "the Church is the Bride of Christ.")



5. All have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. (Hold up all your fingers and point towards your pinky finger, your shortest finger, and quote Romans 3:23)



6. God has given us the gift of eternal life and His Holy Spirit. (Hold out your hand as if you are about to receive a gift)



7. We are waiting for the hope of the resurrection. (Raise your open palm in the air towards the sky)
