## 201: EVIDENCE

Who is God? You do not need a theology, philosophy, or science degree to answer this question. Every human has the tools they need to connect the dots to know that God exists. God, in his infinite wisdom and power, created the world as a witness to his glory. Much can be known about God simply by observing the design of the universe and the nature of humans.

**Memory Verses:** Gen. 1:1; Ex. 20:11; Heb. 3:4

### Key Points

- Everything that has a beginning has a cause. The universe has a beginning; therefore, the universe has a cause—God.
- Every design has a designer. The universe displays a staggering amount of design; therefore, the universe has a Designer.
- If objective moral values and obligations exist, God exists. Objective moral values and obligations exist; therefore, God exists.
- The universe needs a spaceless, timeless, immaterial, and personal first cause, which are precisely the characteristics of God.
- God does not need a beginning because he is eternal and self-sufficient.
